Project #1: Spearhead a Summer Speaker Series for the **Innovation Lab**

This series is designed to educate and inspire prospective entrepreneurs by highlighting gaps in the market and challenge them to address those gaps with innovative and sustainable for-profit business solutions. During the 2020 Summer Speaker Series, Bethesda Green welcomed 18 speakers, including founders, industry experts, and policy makers, to come together to discuss two primary topics: 1) Building a More Flexible, Efficient, and Sustainable Food System and 2) Establishing a Circular Economy.

This project will involve working at the direction of the Be Green Business Director to:

- determine key topics for this year's speaker series;
- identify and recruit a diverse group of speakers; and
- schedule and help promote the sessions.

Project #2: Strengthen the Innovation Lab Database of Impact Investors

Participants in Bethesda Green's Innovation Lab often require outside capital to build and scale their companies. This project will focus on spearheading efforts to strengthen the Innovation Lab Database of Impact Investors to ensure participating company founders connect with investors aligned with their mission. For this project, the intern will:

- work with Bethesda Green's programmatic team to design marketing content and collateral for the Innovation Lab designed to attract impact investors;
- conduct extensive market research to identify qualified organizations, schedule introductory conversations with an organization's point of contact, and write short summaries of those sessions; and
- write summaries of key organizations to share with portfolio members CEOs and other company executives in the Innovation Lab.
